Region 2 Sam LaCara Administrator of the Year Award

This form, or a photocopy, **must be used** to submit nominations. It takes the place of any résumé or vitae. A criteria explanation is required (two pages maximum). You may also attach a total of two pages of supporting documents, such as newspaper articles and letters of support. Nominations must be submitted to Darrien Johnson, Region 2 Past President, for selection.

Purpose

This award recognizes outstanding leadership and significant contributions to education by a school administrator. It was established to honor the memory of Sam LaCara, the beloved principal of Louisiana Schnell Elementary School in the Placerville Unified School District.

Eligibility

The recipient should be an ACSA member who personifies the ideals of Sam LaCara and be an administrator who motivates and inspires students, parents and colleagues; is a skilled manager willing to go the extra mile to get things done; is dedicated to the educational profession and is actively involved in ACSA at the charter, region or state level; volunteers in the community to work with youth; establishes relationships and connections with community organizations that benefit children; advocates for at-risk and disenfranchised children; demonstrates integrity and a positive outlook. Current ACSA employees and ACSA board members are not eligible to receive this award.

Criteria

Awarded to **an ACSA member** exemplifying the following criteria. **Attach an additional two pages maximum explaining how your nominee meets these criteria, providing specific examples.** These two pages are in addition to your two optional pages of supporting documents.

- 1) An administrator who motivates and inspires students, parents and colleagues.
- 2) An administrator who is a skilled manager willing to go the extra mile to get things done.
- 3) An administrator who is actively involved in ACSA at the charter, region or state level.
- 4) An administrator who volunteers in the community to work with youth
- 5) An administrator who establish relationships and connections with community organizations that benefits children.
- 6) An administrator who advocates for at risk and disenfranchised children.
- 7) An administrator who demonstrates integrity and a positive outlook.
